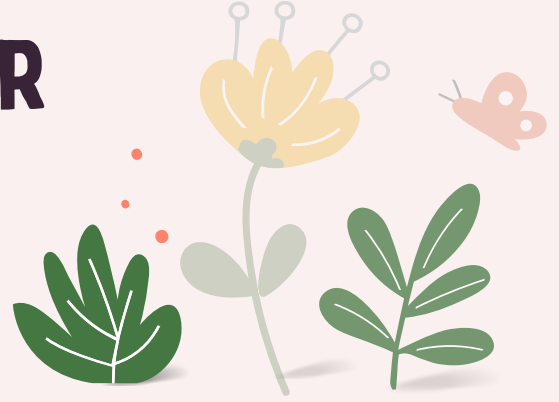

Was followed by some of our residents who also enjoyed a bit of creativity of their own making with some lovely flower arranging as you may agree hard to pick out a winner here!!

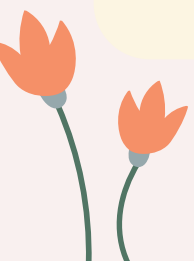


ST BARNABAS CHURCH
